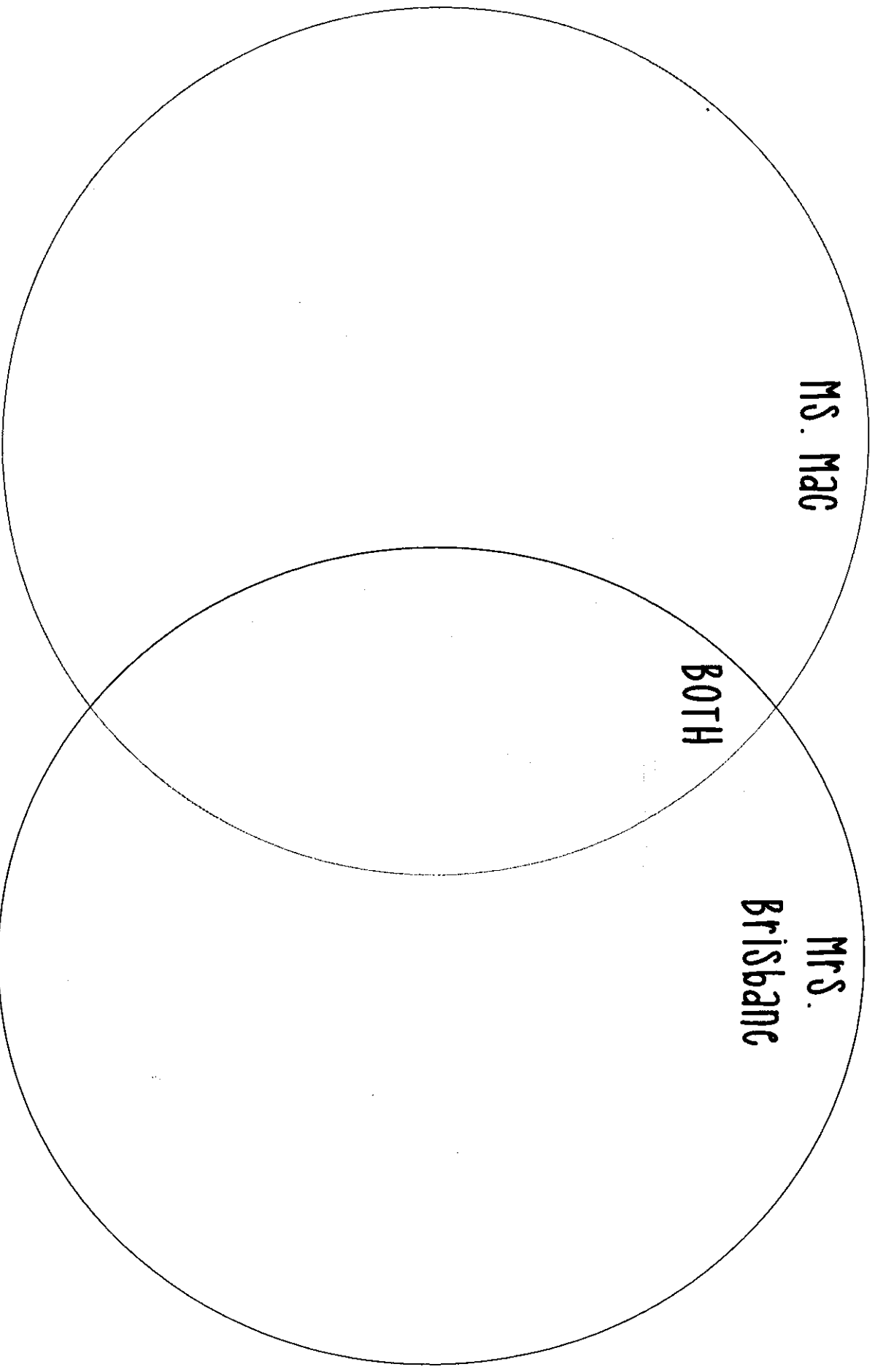

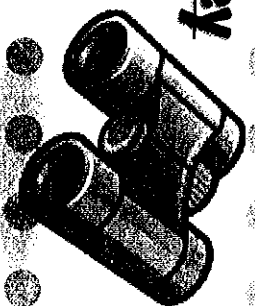
The World According to Humphrey Vivid Verb Search!
